2. Trusting, 3:17-19

a. Irreversible Judgment, 3:17

Hab. 3:17 Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: <u>Major Message</u>

Minor Prophets... Psa. 18:46 The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.

b. Irrepressible Joy, 3:18-19

<u>Psa. 5:11</u> But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

<u>Psa. 31:7</u> I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;

Ps 32:11 Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are upright in heart. ...Major Message

Phil. 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice.

Lu. 10:20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

<u>1 Thess. 5:16 Rejoice evermore.</u>

<u>17</u> Pray without ceasing. <u>18</u> In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

<u>1 Pet. 1:8</u> Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

(Israel – 2nd Coming – <u>Isa. 41:16, 61:10, 65:8-14, Joel 2:18-23,</u> Zeph. 3:11-14, Zech. 2:7-10, 10:6-7)

<u>Neh. 8:10</u> Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

Phil. 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Psa. 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.

31 For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God? 32 It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.

33 He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places.

34 He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.

35 Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great. 36 Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip. Warren Wiersbe - "Habakkuk teaches us to face our doubts and questions honestly take them humbly to the Lord •wait for His Word to teach us •worship Him no matter how we feel or what we see."

•God does not always change the circumstances to fit us and our wants, but if we humbly submit to Him and His will, He will change us to have strength for the circumstances we face.

<u>Conclusion</u>

<u>1 Kgs. 19:11</u> And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but **the LORD was not in the wind**: and after the wind an earthquake; but **the LORD was not in the earthquake**:

<u>12</u> And after the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.

<u>13</u> I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. <u>14</u> Notwithstanding ye have well done, that ye did communicate with my affliction.

<u>15</u> Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.

<u>16</u> For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity. <u>17</u> Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.

<u>18</u> But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

<u>19</u> But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus. ...Major Message
