

THE MINOR PROPHETS

The Book of Zephaniah

Zeph. 3:5-13



Zeph. 3:5 The just LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame. <u>6</u> I have cut off the nations: their towers are desolate; I made their streets waste, that none passeth by: their cities are destroyed, so that there is no man, that there is none inhabitant.

<u>7</u> I said, Surely thou wilt fear me, thou wilt receive instruction; so their dwelling should not be cut off, howsoever I punished them: but they rose early, and corrupted all their doings. <u>8</u> Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.

<u>9</u> For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent.

<u>10</u> From beyond the rivers of Ethiopia my suppliants, even the daughter of my dispersed, shall bring mine offering. <u>11</u> In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain.

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(1) No Regard for God's Presence, 3:5

Zeph. 3:5 The just LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame.

Deut. 32:4 He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

Jer. 3:3 Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

<u>Prov. 11:2</u> When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom.

(2) No Response to God's Patience, 3:6

Zeph. 3:6 I have cut off the nations: their towers are desolate; I made their streets waste, that none passeth by: their cities are destroyed, so that there is no man, that there is none inhabitant.

(3) No Repentance at God's Persistence, 3:7

Zeph. 3:7 I said, Surely thou wilt fear me, thou wilt receive instruction; so their dwelling should not be cut off, howsoever I punished them: but they rose early, *Major Message* and corrupted all their doings.

Minor Prophets... <u>Heb. 3:12</u> Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. <u>13</u> But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; **lest** any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

(4) No Realization o God's Purpose,3:8

Zeph. 3:8 Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.

(a) To Assemble the Nations for Judgment, 3:8a

Zeph. 3:8 "Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey..."

Zech. 14:2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle...

Rev. 16:14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, *which* go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.... <u>16</u> And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon. *...Major Message*

(b) To Assail the Nations in Judgment, 3:8b

Zeph. 3:8b "...for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy."

Zech. 14:2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

Isa. 30:27 Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning with his anger, and the burden thereof is heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:

28 And his breath, as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity: and *there shall be* a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing *them* to err.

<u>Mt. 13:30</u> Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, **Gather ye** together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

III. THE DELIVERANCE OF THE LORD, 3:9-20

A. Israel's Responsibility, 3:9-10

<u>Zeph. 3:9</u> For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent. <u>10</u> From beyond the rivers of Ethiopia my suppliants, even the daughter of my dispersed, shall bring mine offering.

1. The Conversion of the Nations, 3:9

Zeph. 3:9 For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent. Minor Prophets... Acts 26:14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

2. The Cooperation of the Nations, 3:10

Zeph. 3:10 From beyond the rivers of Ethiopia my suppliants, even the daughter of my dispersed, shall bring mine offering.

B. Israel's Repentance, 3:11-13

Zeph. 3:11 In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain. 12 I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD.

<u>13</u> The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid.

1. A New Humility, 3:11-12

Zeph. 3:11 In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain. 12 I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD.



2. A New Holiness, 3:13

Zeph. 3:13 The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid.



Conclusion

Three ways to know that we are God's children:

•3:9 ...when we are in fellowship with the Lord via prayer and service – "...call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him..."

•3:11 ...when we are humble with a meek spirit – "...thou shalt no more be haughty..."

•3:13 ...when we are living a holy life of obedience – "...shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid."

<u>Jn. 14:15</u> If ye love me, keep my commandments. <u>22</u> Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? <u>23</u> Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. <u>24</u> He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.

<u>1 Jn. 5:2</u> By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. <u>3</u> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.
