# THANKSGIVING

Psalm 105:1-5

Thanksgiving 2015



Psa. 105:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people.

2 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: talk ye of all his wondrous works.

3 Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

4 Seek the LORD, and his strength: seek his face evermore.

5 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;

*“How to Celebrate Thanksgiving”* can be summed up in three words:

- PRAISE
- PRAY
- PROCLAIM



## I. CELEBRATE WITH PRAISING

- Give thanks – v. 1

Psa. 105:1 “**O give thanks unto the LORD...**”

Psa. 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and **give thanks** at the remembrance of his holiness.

- Sing – v.2

Psa. 105:2 “**Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him...**”

Psa. 30:4 **Sing unto the LORD**, O ye saints of his, and **give thanks** at the remembrance of his holiness.

- Glory – v. 3

Psa. 105:3 “**Glory ye in his holy name...**”

Psa. 30:12 To the end that **my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.**



## II. CELEBRATE WITH PRAYING

- Call upon His name – v. 1

Psa. 105:1 “O give thanks unto the LORD; **call upon his name...**”

- Seek the LORD – vs.3-4

Psa. 105:3 Glory ye in his holy name: **let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.**

4 **Seek the LORD, and his strength: seek his face evermore.**



### III. CELEBRATE WITH PROCLAIMING

- Make known His deeds – v. 1

Psa. 105:1 “O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name:  
**make known his deeds among the people.**”

2 Sam. 22:50 Therefore I will **give thanks** unto thee, O LORD,  
among the heathen, and I will sing praises unto thy name.

1 Chron. 16:8 **Give thanks** unto the LORD, call upon his name,  
make known his deeds among the people.



- Talk of His wondrous works – v. 2

Psa. 105:2 “Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: **talk ye of all his wondrous works.**”

1 Chron. 16:9 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, **talk ye of all his wondrous works.**

Psa. 26:7 That I may publish with the voice of thanksgiving, and **tell of all thy wondrous works.**

Psa. 145:5 **I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty,** and of **thy wondrous works.**



## Conclusion

ALL OF THE ABOVE! – v. 5

Psa. 105:5 **Remember his** marvellous works that **he hath done; his wonders**, and the judgments of **his mouth**;

- PRAISE
- PRAY
- PROCLAIM
- PRAISE = Attitude
- PRAY = Humility
- PROCLAIM = Boldness
