The "Valley of Dry Bones"

<u>Rom. 8:24</u> For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? <u>25</u> But if we hope for that we see not, *then* do we with patience wait for *it*. <u>Heb. 11:1</u> Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

<u>7</u> By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

HOPE IS BORN IN THE TRUE MEANING OF CHRISTMAS

I. <u>FAITH IS PROPERLY DIRECTED</u>, 1:4a – "...Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus..."

A. Faith must be discerned – "...Since we heard of **your** faith..."

Lu. 8:23 But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy. 24 And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master,

<u>24</u> And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.

25 And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! for he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him.

B. Faith must be directed – "...in Christ Jesus..."

<u>Acts 24:24</u> And after certain days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess, he sent for Paul, and heard him concerning the faith in Christ.

Gal. 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

<u>Gal. 2:20</u> I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

<u>1 Jn. 5:12</u> He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

II. LOVE IS PRESENTLY DISPLAYED, 1:4b – "...the love which ye have to all the saints,"

A. The Impact of the Savior – "...the love which ye have..."

<u>Gal. 5:6</u> For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

<u>Eph. 5:2</u> And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

B. The Inclusiveness for the Saints – "...to all the saints,"

<u>1 Jn. 3:23</u> And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

<u>1 Jn. 5:1</u> Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

III. HOPE IS PERMANENTLY DETERMINED, 1:5-6

<u>1:5</u> For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; <u>6</u> Which is come unto you, as *it is* in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as *it doth* also in you, since the day ye heard *of it*, and knew the grace of God in truth:

A. The Source of the Believers' Hope

"...in the word of the truth of the gospel;"

"...laid up...in heaven..."

B. The Steadfastness in the Believers' Heart

<u>Heb. 6:18</u> That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

<u>19</u> Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

C. The Substance for the Believers' Harvest

<u>1:6</u> Which is come unto you, as *it is* in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as *it doth* also in you, since the day ye heard *of it*, and knew the grace of God in truth:

IV. TRUTH IS PERSONALLY DECLARED, 1:7-8

<u>1:7</u> As ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ;
<u>8</u> Who also declared unto us your love in the Spirit.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

<u>Conclusion</u>

<u>1 Jn. 3:1</u> Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. <u>2</u> Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. <u>3</u> And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
