- B. We Must Center the Savior as Preeminent "Acquaint now thyself with him..."

Col. 1:18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

II. THE PROVISIONS FOR SUCCESS, 22:21

Job 22:21 Acquaint now thyself with him, and be at peace: thereby good shall come unto thee.

A. The Privilege of Peace — "...at peace..."

<u>Jn. 14:27</u> Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Jn. 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Rom. 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Rom. 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

B. The Provision with Peace — "...thereby good shall come unto thee."

Rom. 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Rom. 12:9 Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.

Col. 1:10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

1 Thess. 5:21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

<u>Jas. 4:17</u> Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

- <u>Job 28:12</u> But where shall wisdom be found? and where *is* the place of understanding?
- 16 It cannot be valued with the gold of Ophir, with the precious onyx, or the sapphire.
 - C. The Protection, 22:25
- 22:25 Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.
 - D. The Prayers, 22:26-27
- 22:26 For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God.

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E. The Proclamation, 22:28
