

Minor Prophets...THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES



Mary is crowned as Queen of heaven and earth, Queen of angels and saints.

What is the purpose of all the mysteries of Christ?

To be the pattern of our supernatural life, the means of our sanctification, the source of all our holiness. To create an eternal and glorious society of brethren who will be like unto Him.  ...Major Message

- 2 Cor. 11:13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.
- 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- 15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

Minor Prophets...Lilith in the Talmud and in Midrash

Lilith is mentioned four times in the Babylonian Talmud, though in each of these cases she is not referred to as Adam's wife. BT Niddah 24b discusses her in relation to abnormal fetuses and uncleanness, saying: "If an abortion had the likeness of Lilith its mother is unclean by reason of the birth, for it is a child, but it has wings." Minor Prophets... Conclusion

Psa. 103:11 For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

Psa. 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

Jer. 32:39 And I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:

40 And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me.

Ezek. 36:25 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.
