I. THE EXEMPLAR OF LOVE, 15:9-10

Jn. 15:9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.

<u>10</u> If ye keep my commandments, **ye shall abide in my love**; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

A. Fellowship is Continuing in Faithfulness, 15:9

Jn. 15:9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.

B. Faithfulness is the Condition of Fellowship, 15:10

<u>Jn. 15:10</u> If ye keep my commandments, **ye shall abide in my love**; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

- God's commandments are the common bonds of fellowship.
- As our Creator, He knows what we need to do, for our benefit, and when we trust Him by implementing simple obedience, we are building a bridge of mutual trust.
- God trusts us with His work, and when we do it His way, we are exhibiting respect and trust in His guidance.
- An emotional effort that includes reciprocation, faithfulness, builds a stronger bridge called fellowship.

II. THE ELATION OF LOVE, 15:11

Jn. 15:11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

A. The Purpose of the Message – <u>Jn. 15:11a</u> "These things have I spoken unto you, that..."

B. The Presence of the Magnitude – <u>Jn. 15:11b</u> "...my joy might remain in you, and *that* your joy might be full."

The joy of Christ taking up residence in us!

The joy for us, being full, or complete, will be lacking nothing!

Psa. 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

III. THE EXAMPLE OF LOVE, 15:12-13

<u>Jn. 15:12</u> This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. <u>13</u> Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

> A. The Standard for Friendship, 15:12 = love one another as Christ loves us!

B. The Super Friend, 15:13

 The ultimate standard for friendship as declared by Christ – "Greater love hath no man than this..."

 The ultimate sacrificial love was done by Christ – "...that a man lay down his life for his friends." <u>1 Jn. 4:9</u> In this was **manifested the love of God toward us**, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. <u>10</u> Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

IV. THE EXPECTATION OF LOVE, 15:14

Jn. 15:14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.

A. The Confirmation of Christ – "Ye are my friends..."

Prov. 17:17 A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

<u>Heb. 13:5</u> Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

B. The Conditional Caveat – "...if ye do whatsoever I command you."

Eph. 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

<u>Gal. 2:16</u> Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

<u>Jas 2:17</u> Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. <u>18</u> Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

Jas 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

Jas 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Gal. 5:6b "...faith which worketh by love."

- We are saved by grace, through faith.
- Works cannot save us.
- Salvation is the gift of God.
- Our works verify our faith.
- Our faith is fueled by love.
- Our works of faith testify of our love to the Lord Jesus Christ.
- We serve Him because we love Him!

<u>Jn. 14:15</u> If ye love me, keep my commandments. <u>21</u> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

23 Jesus answered and said unto him, **If a man love me, he will keep my words**: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

24 He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.



<u>1 Jn. 5:3</u> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

<u>1 Jn. 4:19</u> We love him,

because

he first loved us.
