

Mal. 2:1 And now, O ye priests, this commandment is for you.

2 If ye will not hear, and if ye will not lay *it* to heart, to give glory unto my name, saith the LORD of hosts, I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay *it* to heart.

3 Behold, I will corrupt your seed, and spread dung upon your faces, *even* the dung of your solemn feasts; and *one* shall take you away with it.

4 And ye shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my covenant might be with Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

<u>5</u> My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him *for* the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name.

(b) The Threat of the Message, 2:2b-3

i. A Shattering Curse, 2:2b

Mal. 2:2b "...yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay it to heart.

Deut. 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Mal. 2:3 Behold, I will corrupt your seed, and spread dung upon your faces, even the dung of your solemn feasts; and one shall take you away with it."

(3) What He Said Surely, 2:4

Mal. 2:4 And ye shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my covenant might be with Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

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In our day, knowledge is not usually the problem – belief and obedience is!

(<u>Deut. 33:8-11</u>; cf. <u>Exod. 32:25-29</u>; <u>Num. 3:12</u>; <u>25:10-13</u>; <u>Neh. 13:29</u>; <u>Jer. 33:21-22</u>).

Jer. 33:21 Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers.

22 As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me.

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Mal. 2:5a "My covenant was with him of life and peace.

- (b) Levi's Obedience, 2:5b-6
 - i. His Godly Inclination, 2:5b-6a

Mal. 2:5 "...and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name. 6a The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in

his lips:

ii. His Godly Influence, 2:6b

Mal. 2:6b "...he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity."

(2) A Lesson for the Present, 2:7

Mal. 2:7 For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he *is* the messenger of the LORD of hosts.

c. God's Contempt for the Priests, 2:8-9

(1) Their Abandonment of God, 2:8

Mal. 2:8 But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

(2) Their Abasement by God, 2:9

Mal. 2:9 Therefore have I also made you contemptible and base before all the people, according as ye have not kept my ways, but have been partial in the law.

Minor Prophets... Conclusion

Heb. 3:1 Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;

Psa. 110:4 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

Heb. 7:21 (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) Heb. 5:6, 10, 6:20, 7:11, 17

- 1 Pet. 2:1 Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,
- 2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:
- 3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.
- 4 To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious,
- 5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. ...
- 9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:
- 10 Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.
