## THREE ABIDING THINGS

1. Paul appears to place a premium on these three things.

Fail: *katargeō*. To render idle, unemployed, inactivate, inoperative. Cease: *pauō*. . To make to cease or desist

- Vanish away: katargeō. To render idle, unemployed, inactivate, inoperative.
- Done away: katargeō. . To render idle, unemployed, inactivate, inoperative.
- Abideth: *menō*. To continue to be, not to perish, to last, endure.

Colossians 1:4-5 Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints, <sup>5</sup> For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

1 Thessalonians 5:8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

- 2. Paul details the activity of the three remaining things.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:1-3 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>2</sup> We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;
- <sup>3</sup>Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

I. FAITH WORKS. [Remembering without ceasing your work of faith.]

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

James 2:17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone....20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?...... 26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

**Titus 1:16** They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

II. LOVE LABORS. [3 Remembering without ceasing your.... labour of love.]

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Labor: *kopos*. Intense labour united with trouble and toil.

## 1 Corinthians 13:4-8

- 1. 4 Charity suffereth long,
- 2. and is kind;
- 3. charity envieth not;
- 4. charity vaunteth not itself,
- 5. is not puffed up,
- 6. 5 Doth not behave itself unseemly,
- 7. seeketh not her own,
- 8. is not easily provoked,
- 9. thinketh no evil:
- 10. 6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity,
- 11. but rejoiceth in the truth;
- 12. <sup>7</sup> Beareth all things,
- 13. believeth all things,
- 14. hopeth all things,
- 15. endureth all things.

## Love is very vulnerable!

Matthew 24:9-12 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. <sup>10</sup> And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. <sup>11</sup> And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. <sup>12</sup> And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

III. HOPE WAITS. [3 Remembering without ceasing your .....patience of hope.]

Patience: hypomonē. A patient enduring, sustaining, perseverance

**Romans 8:25** But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with <u>patience</u> wait for it.

Hebrews 10:36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

1 Corinthians 1:7 So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ:
