I. MORE THAN WORDS

Galatians 6:6 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things.

⁷ Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

- Communicate: koinōneō. To give a share.
- The Principle Established.
- It is more than telling Pastor we appreciate him, the principle states we are to give a share.

II. MOSTLY THE WORDS.

1 Timothy 5:17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.

¹⁸ For the scripture saith, thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer is worthy of his reward.

- Especially: most of all. How the Word of God is dealt with is the ultimate motivation for our giving honor to the pastor.
- Honor: *timē*. A valuing objectively (existing outside the mind). Substance!
- Labour: *kopiaō*. To grow weary and exhausted.
