

Hag. 1:7-9

Hag 1:7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your ways. 8 Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.

9 Ye looked for much, and, lo, it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

The present state of the church lends itself to the need to assess, agree and act.

Eccl. 3:1 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

## I. THE TIME TO ASSESS

Hag 1:7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your ways. 9 Ye looked for much, and, lo, it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

- A. The Estimation "...Consider your ways."
- Estimation, collectively, includes all of us and gives a general consensus.
- Estimation, individually, implicitly faces the reality of truthfulness.

#### B. The Evaluation

Hag 1:9 Ye looked for much, and, lo, it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

Priorities, evaluated properly, must be implemented faithfully.

Mt. 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by *his* fruit.

## II. THE TIME TO AGREE

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

A. The church is the Lord's

Eph. 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Col. 2:17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.

B. The church is the Lord working through us.

Rom 12:5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

1 Co 12:27 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Eph 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

## III. THE TIME TO ACT

Hag 1:8 Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.
