Carry the Light

<u>Mt. 5:14-16</u> "Carry the Light to Exhibit God's Greatness" Mt. 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

As we come down to the last month of the year, our minds are turned toward the most anticipated holiday of the year – Christmas! Our theme this year has been...

Carry the Light

The conduct of a true Christian, one who is genuinely "born again," is the outcome of a doctrinal foundation. We are "living out our faith," and our testimony indicates the quality of it, be it good or bad.

As I believe, therefore I live.

During this Christmas season, we have a wonderful opportunity to let our light shine, living out our faith before others. In doing so, let's take a look at our motive: why should we be concerned to let our light shine?

According to our text, the Lord Jesus Christ commands us to be *carrying the light*. Our passage gives us the direction and motive to do so.

I. CARRY THE LIGHT TO EXHIBIT GOD'S GREATNESS

A. God's Greatness via Normal Conversation

Mt. 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. <u>15</u> Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

The purpose and function of a light is simply to shine.

 The way a believer functions in life is called *conversation* in the Bible.

ἀναστροφή – properly, 'walk,' i. e. manner of life, behavior, conduct https://www.blueletterbible.org/lang/Lexicon/Lexicon.cfm?strongs=G391&t=KJV • *Conversation* is simply one's manner of life.

Psa. 50:23 Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth *his* conversation *aright* will I shew the salvation of God.

 We have a responsibility to "order our conversation aright."

<u>2 Cor. 1:12</u> For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.

Phil. 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

This is how we let our light shine – by living what we profess!

The greatest single cause of atheism in the world today is Christians who acknowledge Jesus with their lips then walk out the door and deny him by their lifestyle. That is what an unbelieving world simply finds unbelievable.

 The reason why we let our light shine is to glorify our Heavenly Father!

B. God's Greatness via the Natural Creation

<u>Psa. 19:1</u> The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
<u>2</u> Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.
<u>3</u> There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.

Rom. 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; 19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. 20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: 21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Heb. 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

- The beauty of creation declares "GOD MADE ME FOR HIS GLORY!"
- The believer's life should be declaring "LOOK WHAT GOD HAS DONE THROUGH ME!"

Isa. 43:7 Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. <u>Rom. 3:23</u> For all have sinned, and **come short of the glory of God**;

Phil. 2:11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

C. God's Greatness via the New Creature

<u>2 Cor. 5:14</u> For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
<u>15</u> And *that* he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. ...
<u>17</u> Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Mt. 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

<u>Conclusion</u>

Eph. 2:1 And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: <u>3</u> Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others. **<u>4</u>** But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, 5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus: 7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
