(1) How we know we love God personally - we love God's people, 5:1

<u>1 Jn. 5:1</u> Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

Jn. 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

(2) How we know we love God's people – we love God personally, 5:2

<u>1 Jn. 5:2</u> By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

 If we love God, we keep His commandments, one of which is to love the brethren.

Jn. 13:35 By this shall all men **know that ye are my disciples**, if ye have love one to another.

b. Our attitude toward God's challenge, 5:3-5

(1) To obey the Word, 5:3

<u>1 Jn. 5:3</u> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

<u>Jn. 14:15</u> If ye love me, keep my commandments. ... <u>21</u> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. ... <u>23</u> Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. <u>24</u> He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the

word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.

Original Word: βαρύς Transliteration: barus Definition: heavy, weighty, burdensome, lit. and met; violent, oppressive.

*barýs* – (an adjective, also used substantively) – properly, heavy (weighty); (figuratively) what is grievous (burdensome), *pressing down* on a person with oppressive force. Such a grievous burden makes a person unable to function (enjoy free movement). <u>http://biblehub.com/greek/926.htm</u>

## Mt. 11:30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

<u>1 Jn. 4:4</u> Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

<u>Eph. 3:16</u> That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, **to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man**;

- <u>17</u> That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
- <u>18</u> May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

<u>19</u> And **to know the love of Christ**, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

(2) To overcome the world, 5:4-5

(a) Victory expected, 5:4a "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world..."

Rom. 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

<u>1 Cor. 15:57</u> But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

(b) Victory explained, 5:4b-5 "...and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. <u>5</u> Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?"
