Building Up Your Potential By Surrendering To The Great Commission

Aquila & Priscilla - The Importance of Surrender

<u>Acts 18:1</u> After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth; <u>2</u> And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.

<u>3</u> And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.

I. They were completely sold out to God.

Acts 18:18 And Paul *after this* tarried *there* yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn *his* head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow. II. They were doctrinally sound in their faith.

<u>Acts 18:19</u> And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered into the synagogue, and reasoned with the Jews.

<u>20</u> When they desired *him* to tarry longer time with them, he consented not; <u>21</u> But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

<u>Acts 18:24</u> And a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man, *and* mighty in the scriptures, came to Ephesus.

25 This man was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in the spirit, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John. 26 And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto *them*, and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.

27 And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through grace:

28 For he mightily convinced the Jews, and that publickly, shewing by the scriptures that Jesus was Christ.

III. They had a good testimony among the brethren.

<u>Acts 19:21</u> And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples,

<u>1 Cor. 16:19</u> The churches of Asia salute you. Aquila and Priscilla salute you much in the Lord, with the church that is in their house.
