<u>Rev. 2:18</u> And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass; <u>19</u> I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. 20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. 21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. 22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. 23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden. 25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come. 26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: 27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. 28 And I will give him the morning star. 29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.



IV. <u>THYATIRA: THE FALSE CHURCH</u>, 2:18-29 (A.D. 500-1000) A. What the Lord Detected About This Church, 2:18-19 1. What He Emphasized About His Person, 2:18 <u>Rev. 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write;</u> These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass; Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard *us*: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.



<u>1 Pet. 4:17</u> For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?

2. What He Emphasized About His People, 2:19

<u>Rev. 2:19</u> I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last *to be* more than the first.

Thyatira had a wonderful list of what the Lord Jesus Christ found commendable:

- Works
- Charity
- Service
- Faith
- Patience
- Works

Eph. 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God:
9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

<u>Titus 2:7</u> In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine *shewing* uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, ... <u>14</u> Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. <u>Titus 3:5</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; ... <u>8</u> This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might **be careful to maintain good works**. These things are good and profitable unto men. ... <u>14</u> And let ours also learn to maintain good works for

necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.

Jas. 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

B. What the Lord Detested About This Church, 2:20-23

1. The Source of the Heresy, 2:20a "Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because **thou sufferest that woman Jezebel**, which calleth herself a prophetess, **to teach**..."

<u>1 Kings 16:31</u> And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him. <u>Judges 18:7</u> Then the five men departed, and came to Laish, and saw the people that *were* therein, **how they dwelt careless, after the manner of the Zidonians**, quiet and secure; and *there was* no magistrate in the land, that might put *them* to shame in *any* thing; and they *were* far from the Zidonians, and had no business with *any* man.

<u>1 Kings 11:5</u> For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites.

2. The Seriousness of the Heresy, 2:20b "...and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols."

<u>1 Cor. 6:9</u> Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, <u>10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. <u>11</u> And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.</u>

3. The Stubbornness of the Heresy, 2:21

<u>Rev. 2:21</u> And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

4. The Suppression of the Heresy, 2:22-23

<u>Rev. 2:22</u> Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

Jer. 17:10 I the LORD search the heart, *I* try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, *and* according to the fruit of his doings.

1. The Overseer and His Fellows, 2:24-25

<u>Rev. 2:24</u> But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden. <u>25</u> But that which ye have *already* hold fast till I come.

2. The Overcomer and His Future, 2:26-29

<u>Rev. 2:26</u> And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:
<u>27</u> And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
<u>28</u> And I will give him the morning star.
<u>29</u> He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

<u>Conclusion</u>
