

### Acts 19:11 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:

- 12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
- 13 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.



The Testimony of the Spirit, 19:15

Acts 19:15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?

The Terror of the Exorcists, 19:16

1 Cor. 5:9 I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:

Rom. 1:15 So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also.

Rom. 15:24 Whensoever I take my journey into Spain, I will come to you: for I trust to see you in my journey, and to be brought on my way thitherward by you, if first I be somewhat filled with your company.

1 Cor. 4:17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

1 Cor. 16:10 Now if Timotheus come, see that he may be with you without fear: for he worketh the work of the Lord, as I also do. 11 Let no man therefore despise him: but conduct him forth in peace, that he may come unto me: for I look for him with the brethren.

Rom 16:23 Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother.

2Ti 4:20 Erastus abode at Corinth: but Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick.
