Insight for the Issues Prov. 4:23



"Christians, Worldview, and Education."

<u>Prov. 4:23</u> Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

<u>Review</u>

In May, we began a new series – "Insight for the Issues" – considering issues that believers must confront during a lifetime. Each generation has its own historical epoch that is unique for their time. Some intellectuals label it *zeitgeist*.

What are the issues facing us in our day? How is a Christian to be prepared to properly face and respond to the constant bombardment of ideas, philosophies, that affect our lives? Should a believer be expected to have a Scriptural perspective or viewpoint regarding politics, lifestyles, and other various issues? Note the following Scriptural perspective: <u>1 Chron. 12:32</u> "...*which were men* that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do..."

Est. 1:13 "...the wise men, which knew the times..."

Eccl. 8:5 "...and a wise man's heart discerneth both time and judgment."

Tonight, our issue is "Christians, Worldview, and Education." We will begin by considering what a "Christian worldview" is.

A worldview is the framework from which we view reality and make sense of life and the world. "[It's] any ideology, philosophy, theology, movement or religion that provides an overarching approach to understanding God, the world and man's relations to God and the world," says David Noebel, author of Understanding the Times.

A biblical worldview is based on the infallible Word of God. When you believe the Bible is entirely true, then you allow it to be the foundation of everything you say and do. That means, for instance, you take seriously the mandate in Romans 13 to honor the governing authorities by researching the candidates and issues, making voting a priority. Do you have a biblical worldview? Answer the following questions, based on claims found in the Bible **and** which George Barna used in his survey:

- Do absolute moral truths exist?
- Is absolute truth defined by the Bible?
- Did Jesus Christ live a sinless life?
- Is God the all-powerful and all-knowing Creator of the universe, and does He still rule it today?
- Is salvation a gift from God that cannot be earned?
- Is Satan real?
- Does a Christian have a responsibility to share his or her faith in Christ with other people?
- Is the Bible accurate in all of its teachings?

Did you answer yes to these? Only 9 percent of "born- again" believers did. But what's more important than your yes to these questions is whether your life shows it. Granted, we are all sinners and fall short, but most of our gut reactions will reflect what we deep-down, honest-to-goodness believe to be real and true.

II. THE FUTILITY OF LYING

Jn. 8:44 Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

<u>Gen. 3:5</u> For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. One example is the humanist Charles Francis Potter's book, *Humanism: A New Religion,* in which he writes, "Education is the most powerful ally of humanism. What can theistic Sunday schools, meeting for an hour once a week, do to stem the tide of a five-day program of humanistic teaching?"

Evolution vs the Bible

Assumptions:

- There is no God (atheism); or, if a god exists, he/she/it left no trace of any creative activity
- 2. The present is the key to the past
- 3. We are here by chance

Mechanism:

- Random mutation with natural selection
- Life appeared and gradually diversified
- 3. No global flood covered the earth

Assumptions:

- 1. In the beginning, God created
- Revelation (God's Word) is the key to the past
- 3. We were created by God

Mechanism:

- 1. Intelligent design
- Universe/life created in six ordinary days approximately
 6,000 years ago
- Noah's flood covered the entire earth

Order of Appearance: (also for 'progressive creation')

- Matter always existed or just appeared
- 2. Sun/stars existed before Earth
- 3. Sun is Earth's first light
- 4. First life = marine organisms
- 5. Reptiles pre-date birds
- 6. Land mammals predate whales
- 7. Disease/death precede man

Order of Appearance:

- 1. God created matter
- 2. Earth created before sun/stars
- 3. Light created before sun
- 4. First life = land plants
- 5. Birds pre-date land reptiles
- Whales pre-date land mammals
- Disease/death result from man's sin



Implications:

- 1. No life after death
- 2. Our present life is all there is

- 1. God is reduced to a creation of man
- 2. God is removed from public life

Areas of Concern

• This LGBTQ special rights ordinance provides for a public accommodation section on page 6 of the ordinance. It allows for persons of any "gender identity or expression" to be allowed in any public restroom of the opposite sex.

• Medina City Schools also have to allow those students that perceive themselves to be transgender to enter restrooms, locker rooms, and showers of the opposite sex.

• Students may be able to choose to compete in sports as a gender opposite of their birth gender.

• The City of Medina would face making costly investigations into citizen claims of discrimination based on gender identity and expression which are difficult to prove.

• Business owners will be faced with the decision to make brick and mortar changes to accommodate a third restroom or face fines.

• These concerns were addressed before City Council by local residents who opposed the ordinance. The Council ignored those concerns and passed the ordinance by a 5-2 margin. That is why we are circulating a referendum to put the issue on the ballot for the citizens to decide.

III. THE FRUITFUL LEGACY

<u>Psa. 127:3</u> Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb *is his* reward.

<u>Rom. 12:2</u> And **be not conformed to this world**: but **be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

<u>Summary</u>

Dawson reminds us: "behind the smokescreen of blue books and handbooks great forces are at work which have changed the lives and thoughts of men more effectively than the arbitrary power of dictators or the violence of political revolutions."¹⁰

He continues his analysis of universal State run education by warning his readers that "...once the State has accepted full responsibility for the education of the whole youth of the nation, it is obliged to extend its control further and further into new fields: to the physical welfare of its pupils - to their feeding and medical care - to their amusements and the use of their spare time – and finally to their moral welfare and their psychological guidance."¹¹ This universal education will only serve to create a new Leviathan which embraces the entire field of culture, including all forms of educational institutions not excluding private nursery schools and universities.¹² Given the disproportion in wealth between religious and other private institutions and the more powerful modern state, the former ones are prone to face a serious financial and academic (curricula determination) crisis in the near future.

Let me conclude this brief article with a note of optimism, quoted from the wise British scholar Christopher Dawson:

"So long as the Christian tradition of higher education still exists, the victory of secularism even in a modern technological society is not complete. There is still a voice to bear witness to the existence of the forgotten world of spiritual reality in which man has his true being."¹³ https://www.iwp.edu/articles/2018/02/01/the-tragedy-of-american-education-the-role-of-john-dewey/
