Rev. 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

2 And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, *and* over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous *are* thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true *are* thy ways, thou King of saints.

d. The Special Commemoration in Heaven, 15:1-8

(1) The Period of Waiting, 15:1-4

Rev. 15:1 **And I saw** another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; **for in them is filled up the wrath of God.**

2 And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, *and* over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

3 And they sing **the song of Moses** the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous *are* thy works, **Lord God Almighty**; just and true *are* thy ways, **thou King of saints.**

Conclusion

Psa. 96:1 **O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.**

2 Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; **shew forth his salvation from day to day.**

3 **Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.**

4 **For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised:** he *is* to be feared above all gods.

5 For all the gods of the nations *are* idols: but the LORD made the heavens.

6 Honour and majesty *are* before him: strength and beauty *are* in his sanctuary.

7 Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

8 **Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name:** bring an offering, and come into his courts.

9 O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.

10 Say among the heathen *that* the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: **he shall judge the people righteously.**

11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.

12 Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice

13 Before the LORD: **for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.**
