

I. The Problem.

 Peter 1: 9 But he that lacketh <u>these things</u> is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

II. The Plan.

A. Virtue. SUNDAY
2 Peter 1:5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue;

1Thessalonians 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:

B. Knowledge. MONDAY 2 Peter 1:5 and to virtue [add] knowledge;

Romans 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. 12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

C. Temperance. TUESDAY 2 Peter 1:6 And to knowledge [add] temperance;

D. Patience. WEDNESDAY 2 Peter 1:6 and to temperance [add] patience;

Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

E. Godliness. THURSDAY 2 Peter 1: 6 and to patience [add] godliness;

F. Brotherly Kindness. FRIDAY 2 Peter 1:7 And to godliness [add] brotherly kindness; G. Charity (love) SATURDAY 2 Peter 1:7and to brotherly kindness charity.

Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Ephesians 5:11 And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.

III. The Promise 2 Peter 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: 11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
