

<u>Ex. 3:14</u>

JESUS – NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES JEHOVAH (I Am That I Am)

Ex. 3:13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, *when* I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and **they shall say to me**, **What** *is* **his name? what shall I say unto them**?

<u>14</u> And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

<u>Psa. 8:1</u> O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens. ...
<u>9</u> O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!

<u>Prov. 18:10</u> The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.

Psa. 34:3 O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.

The Hebrew word that is the English transliteration of "I AM THAT I AM" is commonly called the <u>Tetragrammaton</u>:

Jehovah-Zidkenu – The Lord Our Righteousness **Jehovah-Shammah** = The Lord is There Jehovah-Roi – The Lord is My Shepherd **Jehovah Ropheka** – The Lord Who Heals

<u>Psa. 27:1</u> The LORD *is* my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD *is* the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

- <u>2</u> When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.
- <u>3</u> Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this *will* I *be* confident.
- <u>4</u> One *thing* have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple.
- 5 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.
- <u>6</u> And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD. ...
- <u>14</u> Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Psalm 27 starts out with a descriptive name for God. In the Hebrew, it literally begins with Jehovah-Ori, which is translated "LORD, light," or "the LORD is my light."

Light represents a lot of different things, but tonight, we're going to focus on four aspects in particular. And as we do, each one is going to cast a new ray of light on the significance of the name, Jehovah-Ori.

I. JEHOVAH-ORI IS FOR OUR ILLUMINATION

Psa. 119:130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple. The Word of God is light that gives the believer illumination for clarity in guidance through the darkness of trials.

<u>Psa. 18:28</u> For thou wilt light my candle: **the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness**.

<u>Jn. 3:18</u> He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. <u>19</u> And this is the condemnation, that **light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil**.

<u>20</u> For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.
<u>21</u> But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Truth and light are companions of believers that dispense the darkness of unbelief.

<u>Jn. 12:46</u> I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

II. JEHOVAH-ORI IS FOR OUR INSTRUCTION

Psa. 119:105 Thy word *is* a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

- The Word of God assists believers in evaluating who they are and who they will be.
- The Word of God indicates the believer's location for the present and for the future.

III. JEHOVAH-ORI IS FOR OUR INSPIRATION

<u>Prov. 4:18</u> But the path of the just *is* as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.

- Believers growing in grace are perpetually enlightened in gaining spiritual development.
- As believers are inspired in spiritual development, "walking in the light," so is the fellowship with the Lord intensified.

<u>1 Jn. 1:5</u> This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light, and in him is no darkness at all**. <u>6</u> If we say that we have **fellowship with him**, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

<u>7</u> But **if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another**, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

IV. JEHOVAH-ORI IS FOR OUR INFLUENCE

Believers "walking in the light" are not only reflecting the Lord Jesus Christ, but also identified as light bearers focused upon glorifying God.

Mt. 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

- <u>15</u> Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- <u>16</u> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

The believers' light is an influence originated in the True Light, the Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>Jn. 8:12</u> Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

- Jehovah-Ori is our light for illumination, dispelling the darkest challenges.
- Jehovah-Ori is our light for instruction, directing our clearest paths.
- Jehovah-Ori is our light for inspiration, developing the intensity of our fellowship.
- Jehovah-Ori is our light for influencing others toward knowing the grace and greatness of God.

<u>Conclusion</u>

Jehovah-Ori is the light that provides our confidence. He is the beacon of guidance as we walk through this darkened world. The Lord is our light. He is our Jehovah-Ori.

<u>Isa. 60:1</u> Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. ...

<u>19</u> The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but **the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light**, and thy God thy glory. <u>20</u> Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: **for the LORD shall be thine everlasting light**, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.
